MISS CONGENIALITY

Piñon logs are always crackling in the kivas at the **Inn of the Anasazi, A Rosewood Hotel** (113 Washington Ave.; 505/988-3030; innoftheanasazi.com; doubles from \$349). Just steps from the Plaza, it's a showcase for the Santa Fe look.

SCHEHERAZADE WAS HERE:

The 26 suites at the **Inn of the Five Graces** (150 E. de Vargas St.; 505/992-0957; fivegraces.com; suites from \$385) feel like palace rooms out of the *Arabian Nights*: behind Chinese doors guests sink into kilim-covered sofas and carved teak beds.

STAY AND SOAK

Perched above Santa Fe, **Ten Thousand Waves** (3451 Hyde Park Rd.; 505/982-9304; tenthousandwaves.com; rooms from \$99) is a New Mexican-Japanese *onsen* (hot spring) with private outdoor teak hot tubs. Stay the night in a Zen casita, or an Airstream reinvented as a Japanese sleeping car.
